Madeline Zavodny joined the UNF Department of Economics & Geography in Fall 2017. In addition to being a Professor of Economics at UNF, Dr. Zavodny is a Research Fellow at the Institute of Labor Economics (IZA), a Fellow at the Global Labor Organization, and an Adjunct Scholar at the American Enterprise Institute.

Much of her research focuses on economic issues related to immigration, including *Beside the Golden Door: U.S. Immigration Reform in a New Era of Globalization* (AEI Press, 2010) and *The Economics of Immigration* (Routledge, 2015).

Her research on immigration has also been published in the *Journal of Labor Economics*, *Industrial and Labor Relations Review*, the *Journal of Policy Analysis and Management* and *Demography*, among others.

Before joining UNF she was a professor of economics at Agnes Scott College and Occidental College and an economist with the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta and the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas. She holds a PhD in Economics from MIT and a BA in Economics from Claremont McKenna College. 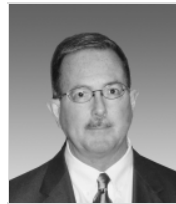
