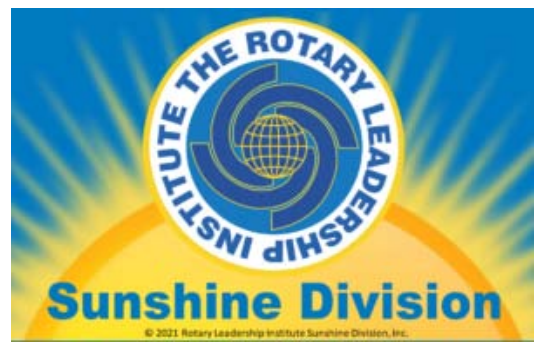

Loneliness and isolation can be a considerable community health issue, especially for older adults.

Exacerbated by COVID-19 pandemic seclusion, loneliness has become a global public health crisis. In the U.S., even before the pandemic, a quarter of Americans aged 65 and older described themselves as socially isolated, including 4 percent, or 1.3 million people, experiencing severe social isolation, according to a 2011 study. In England, members of the Rotary Club of Chichester Priory launched the **Bridging Generations** project, which aims to combat loneliness by connecting college students with older people. Every two weeks, a group of elders has coffee, cake, and a chat with students in the Chichester College canteen.
