Bring in your bottles to participate in the historical Derby Celebration on May 6, 2023.

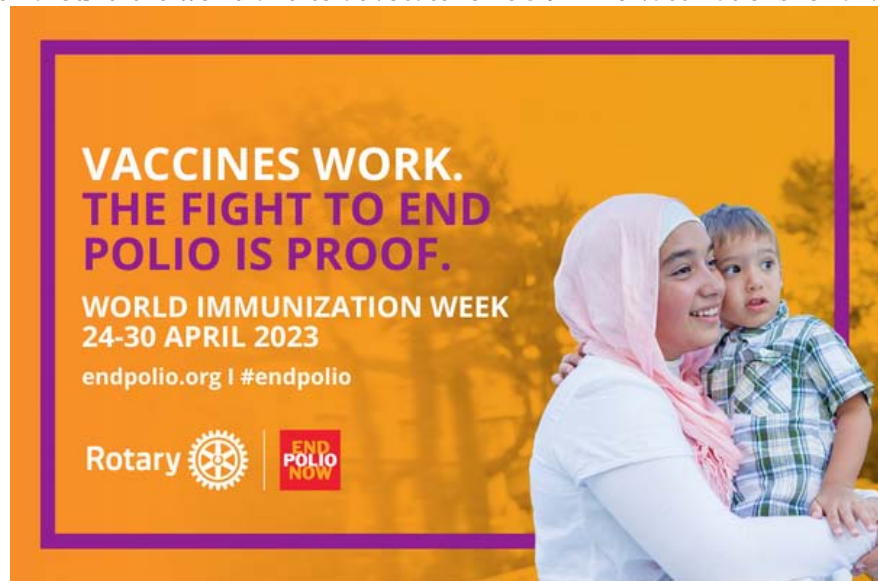
World Immunization Week: April 24-30
