This Tuesday is a field trip to the Museum of Science and History. So don't go to the River City Brewing Restaurant. Instead go across the parking lot and meet in the lobby at MOSH. There we will have a box lunch and learn about the operations of the museum from Maria Hane, president of MOSH and her staff.

During her tenure at MOSH, Maria has completed more than \$1.4 million in capital improvements including opening the new state-of-the-art Bryan-Gooding Planetarium, the largest single-lens planetarium in the nation.

Prior to her position at MOSH, Hane served as Deputy Director of Operations at the Cummer Museum of Art & Gardens and as the Director of Written Communications for Jacksonville Mayor John D. Delaney, where she spearheaded key communication initiatives such as The Better Jacksonville Plan and the Don't Trash Jacksonville campaign.

During her 17-year tenure in the non-profit sector, Hane has served in key positions with extensive experience in volunteer development, communications, governance, and strategic planning. She is an active member of Leadership Jacksonville Class of 2002, was recently selected to serve on the National Arts Strategies Chief Executive Program, and serves on the board of Visit Jacksonville.

Maria graduated summa cum laude from the University of North Florida with a Bachelor of Arts in Communications.

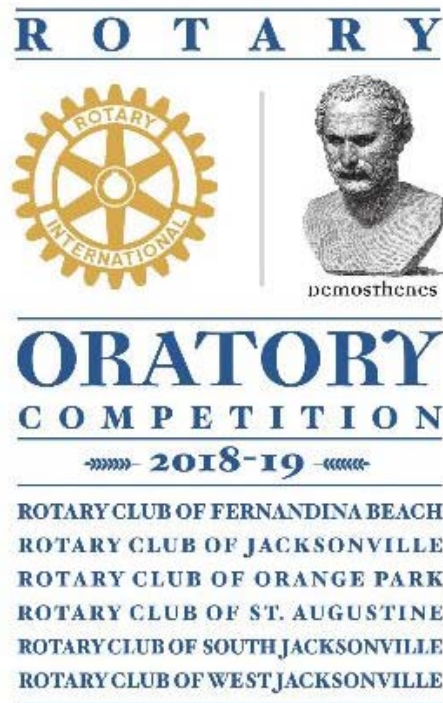
