This Week's Topic: Beth Payne, North Florida Regional Council



Beth Payne, AICP Chief Executive Officer Northeast Florida Regional Council

Beth Payne has worked at the Northeast Florida Regional Council since 2008, with roles in growth management and emergency preparedness. During her tenure, Beth implemented the Statewide Regional Evacuation Study for Northeast Florida region and served as the statewide coordinator. Additionally, she provided oversight and managed the expansion of the Northeast Florida Healthcare Coalition.

Beth became the CEO in 2019 and leads the Council, with direction from the NEFRC Board of Directors, in their work across the seven counties of Northeast Florida. Programs include Emergency Preparedness, Planning and Policy, Resiliency and Economic Development, which are implemented with a team of 18 talented staff

members.

Beth grew up on the Eastern Shore of Virginia and received her undergraduate degree in Geography from James Madison University in Harrisonburg, Virginia and her Masters in Urban and Regional Planning from Virginia Commonwealth University in Richmond, Virginia. She has been living in Northeast Florida for 16 years, raising her three children in Jacksonville.





In addition to Jacksonville University's Nelly Fund being the South Jax Derby main beneficiary of \$10,000, five additional \$1000 grants will be awarded. As members, you have input on which organizations will receive funds.

How it works:

Nominate a non-profit charity with a \$25 donation, prior to the gala or at the event, or if you are a sponsor. If you are a table sponsor, you receive eight nominations! The nominations will be on display at the event.
