## This Week's Topic: Rick Mullaney, Public Policy Institute

Rick Mullaney is the Founding Director of the Jacksonville University Public Policy Institute ("Institute") and a legal and political analyst for WJXT Channel 4 and WOKV, 104.5 FM in Jacksonville, Florida. The Institute was established in 2012 and offers five graduate degree programs in public policy, including a Master in Public Policy (MPP) degree. In 2015, Jacksonville University and the Institute conferred the first MPP degrees in the history of Florida. In addition to leading the Institute, Mullaney teaches a course on Law and Public Policy and provides extensive television and radio commentary as a legal and political analyst. His commentary includes appearances on

WJXT, CBS, NBC, MSNBC, CSPAN, and CNA Singapore, with more than 700 television appearances since 2015.

Mullaney received a BA in Political Science at the University of Florida, attending on a George Smathers Debate Scholarship and graduating First in the College of Arts and Sciences and Phi Beta Kappa. He also graduated from law school at UF, serving as Executive Editor of the Law Review.

In over 40 years in the private and public sectors, Mullaney's career has been in law, government, and higher education. After graduation from law school, he worked as a business lawyer for Carlton, Fields, state prosecutor for a decade, Mayoral Chief of Staff, the City of Jacksonville's longest serving General Counsel (1997 to 2010), Founder of the Public Policy Institute, and the Robert T. Shircliff Chair in Public Policy at Jacksonville University.

During his career, Mullaney has been involved in diverse litigation, public policy initiatives and political campaigns, lectured on legal and public policy topics in more than 20 states, and taught at the University of North Florida and Jacksonville University. He has received the Prosecutor of the Year Award for the state of Florida and the Lawyer of the Year Award for the City of Jacksonville. He ran for Mayor of Jacksonville in 2011.

Mullaney serves on numerous non-profit boards, including the World Affairs Council and the Government and Public Policy Institute for the University of the Bahamas. He is past Board Chair of the Saint Vincent's Healthcare Foundation and Gateway Community Services. Mullaney is a member of Leadership Jacksonville (1988) and Leadership Florida (2001). He and his wife Lynn have been married for over 35 years and have three children – Taylor, Richie, and Katie.

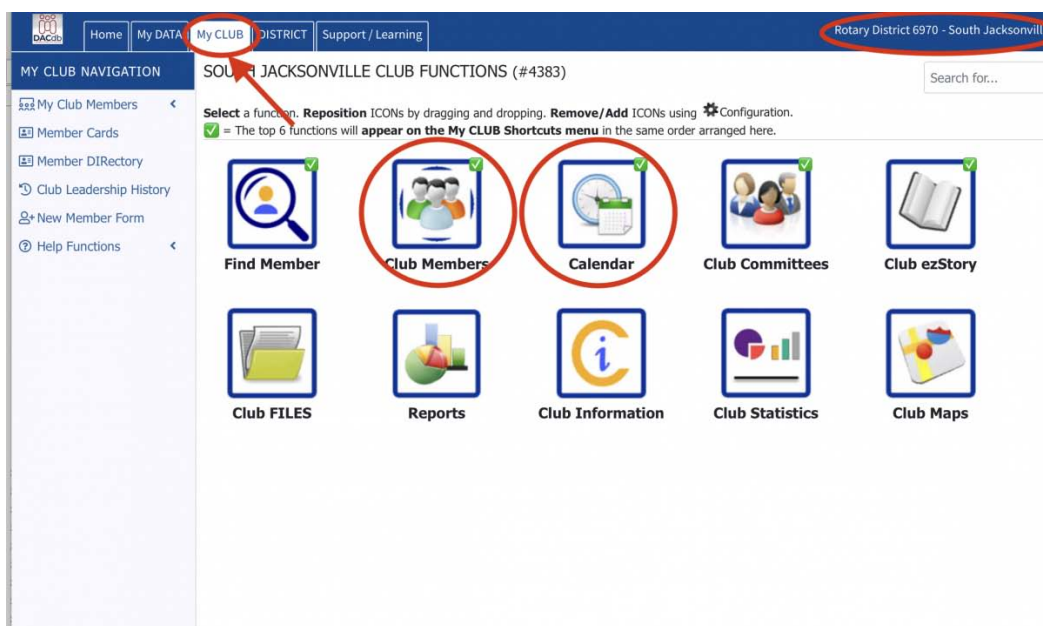

1. DACdb stands for **District And Club DataBase**
