Caroline joined Mayo Clinic in 2016 as an Operations Administrator. She served as the Operations Administrator for several departments and divisions including Hematology and Oncology, Radiation Oncology, as well as, Gastroenterology and Hepatology, General Internal Medicine, Executive Health, Medallion Concierge Medicine, and Ophthalmology. Prior to joining Mayo Clinic, Caroline was the Administrative Director for the Preston Robert Tisch Brain Tumor Center and the Thoracic Oncology Program at Duke University Medical Center and Duke Cancer Institute. Before serving in those roles, Caroline completed an Administrative Fellowship Program at Duke University Medical Center.

Caroline earned her bachelor's degree in commerce and business administration, with a major in healthcare management, from The University of Alabama. She also completed her Master of Science in Health Administration from the University of Alabama at Birmingham. Caroline is actively involved in the American College of Healthcare Executives, serving as Director-At-Large for the North Florida Chapter and she is currently President-Elect for the University of Alabama at Birmingham's School of Health Professions Women in Healthcare Leadership Executive Board.
