Years of Service



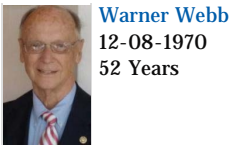

The mission of the Jacksonville Children's Chorus is to provide a high-quality, choral music education for children of diverse backgrounds, fostering teamwork, self-discipline, accomplishment and pride while filling an important cultural need in the community and sharing the beauty of the choral art form through artistically excellent performances.

The Chorus' growth, from 16 voices in 1995 to over 1,000 in year-long choirs and outreach programs today, illustrates its continued impact on our entire community here in Northeast Florida. Over 44% of JCC students receive scholarships to cover tuition costs, and each year the need for scholarships exceeds the funds available. Despite these challenges, it is the JCC's policy to turn no child away who wishes to sing.
