### Kathrvn McAvov The Performers Academy



Kathryn McAvoy began her career in marketing and management at IBM. After 14 years with Big Blue she launched her first business, Acme Barricades and has been a serial entrepreneur ever since. Her extensive entrepreneurial ventures include partnerships ranging from high tech firms to television production, including being the General Partner of two Arena Football Teams, the Jacksonville Tomcats and Birmingham Steeldogs. She launched a local TV Channel, TV Jax, an onsite video website, MeeMee.tv. and produced several feature films.

Kathryn holds a BS in Communications Studies from Northwestern University and an MBA from Jacksonville University. She has served on many non-profit Boards, including the Jacksonville Zoo, Jacksonville Film Events, Books by Kids and the DePaul School. She conducted annual training classes for the United Way of Northeast Florida for more than 15 years, training all the speakers for Charitable Giving Campaigns.

15 years ago, Kathryn founded the nonprofit organization, The Performers Academy (TPA), to provide arts for all, particularly the underserved teens who otherwise wouldn't have access to the arts. The organization has served 100's of teens who reside in licensed or kinship care, are incarcerated, on probation, or attend a court-ordered drug rehabilitation program. UNF's policy of Social Change has documented the positive impact the program has on at-risk youth.

In addition to the special camps TPA does for teens in foster care, TPA also offers a free afterschool art for healing program for middle and high school students, including visual arts, theater, singing, songwriting, music production, podcasting and fashion design. They also have an intense work-readiness program to help inspire and engage the disengaged youth, ages 16 to 23.
