EXCEPTIONAL STUDENTS

Rotary has clubs in over 200 countries. Local Rotary clubs select the best students for participation in the program. The students are smart, engaged, and excited to share their country's unique cultures, traditions, and languages.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- An exchange student from overseas lives in your home as a member of your family, for approximately 3-4 months.
- They are involved with your family, in school, with new friends, and are also active in Rotary events such as conferences and meetings.
- They are 15-18 years old and they are here for 11 months. While the exchange students are here they live with 2 or 3 families to give them a broader understanding of our culture.
- You have extensive support from the local Rotary Club - and over 12,000(!) Rotarians in 275 clubs in participating districts in Florida and Georgia.
- We have had students from Brazil, Italy, Germany, Argentina, Italy, Denmark, Bolivia, Sweden, Belgium, France, Thailand, Japan and many others. They are wonderful young people.
