- The Autism Speaks Walk (under Jim Huster's leadership) raised about \$9500 this year
- The just-completed Food Drive (under Becky Richmond's leadership) to benefit the Y's New Welcome Center and St. Johns Food Pantry was hugely successful
- The newly-formed "Rotary Heroes" Awards (under the leadership of Eli Tavarez and Kelly Sastre) is scheduled to address our club in January
- The Family Picnic/Blessings in a Back Pack event (under Meagan Perkins' leadership) is scheduled for February 6
- The Water for Cambodia project (under Andy Erickson's leadership) will kick off in early February. The ambassador trip to Cambodia by Bob Wiltfong in the new year is back on hold (because of COVID)
- With Becky's help, we continue to explore the possibility of doing a project with YMCA Youth Justice in South Africa
- Confirmed participation in Rise Against Hunger project next February. Linda Lomax agreed to follow up by drafting a grant application to our PV Rotary Foundation for \$750
- The Board recommended a \$500 holiday grant from our PV Rotary Foundation to the Y's New American Welcome Center to assist in its efforts to aid refugees and immigrants

On December 12, 1965, the rookie running back Gale Sayers of the Chicago Bears scores six touchdowns during a single game against the San Francisco 49ers at Chicago's Wrigley Field, tying the National Football League (NFL) record for most touchdowns in a single game.

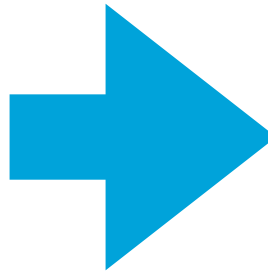

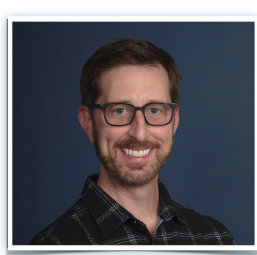

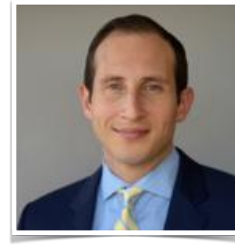
