Fostering Connections is a nonprofit organization that helps youth impacted by foster care by providing needed essentials, educational programs, and community connections. The organization focuses on career readiness, college readiness, and life skills, as well as producing special events that bring the foster parent community together. In three years, Fostering Connections has grown to serve youth from birth through age 24 in five counties (St. Johns, Duval, Putnam, Flagler, and Voluisa) throughout Northeast Florida. Its office is located at The Link in Nocatee.

Aubrie's Rotary experience started in high school when she joined the Interact Club at Nease. In 2019, she became a member of the Rotary Club of St. Augustine Beach, and served as its Secretary during the 2019-2020 Rotary year. In May of 2022, Aubrie transferred her Rotary membership to us at the Rotary Club of Ponte Vedra. She is currently serving on the Community Service Committee and is excited to grow as a Rotarian through our club!

Aubrie is married to her husband Steve, an environmental specialist at the Florida Department of Environmental Protection and adjunct professor at Flagler College, and currently resides in St. Augustine. 
