



From the President's Desk

I was working as a TV news reporter in New York on September 11, 2001. Like a lot of people, I lost a friend that day. Glen Pettit was a videographer for the NYPD and worked weekends with me out on Long Island. The last time we saw Glen, he was following a line of firefighters into the basement of one of the World Trade Center buildings shortly before it collapsed.

The loss, the heartbreak, of that day was enough to make you lose your faith in the kindness of humanity. But that day also displayed some of the best of what we human beings have to offer. The ability to pull together, to help our fellow man/woman was incredible and awe-inspiring. The aftermath

demonstrated to me that there are far more good people in this world than there are bad.

That notion is reinforced with my experience as a Rotarian. "Service above self" isn't just an empty mantra in this organization. It is an actionable way of life. Fred Rogers (aka: "Mr. Rogers") has been quoted as saying that his mother once told him that in a moment of crisis, "look for the helpers." 
