

Mrs. Mickey Reynolds, Ed.D. Principal, Lake Mary High School

Donna "Mickey" Reynolds was born and raised in Sanford, Florida by parents, Don and Ann Reynolds, who served as career educators in Seminole County. Mickey attended Idyllwilde Elementary, Lakeview Middle School, and Lake Mary High School, where her father served as the first principal. After graduating from LMHS in 1986, Mickey attended the University of Florida. After earning her AA degree at UF, Mickey transferred to UCF to complete her Bachelor's degree in English Education. Upon completion of her first three years of teaching English and Dance at University High School in East Orlando, Mickey moved back to Gainesville to teach English, Journalism, and Debate at P.K.
