Dave Joswick is currently in his 23 year as the Executive Director at New Hope for Kids. In his role as ED, Dave oversees the mission of New Hope for Kids that provides specialized support to children and families grieving the death of a loved one and granting wishes to children with life-challenging health condition that reside in Central Florida.

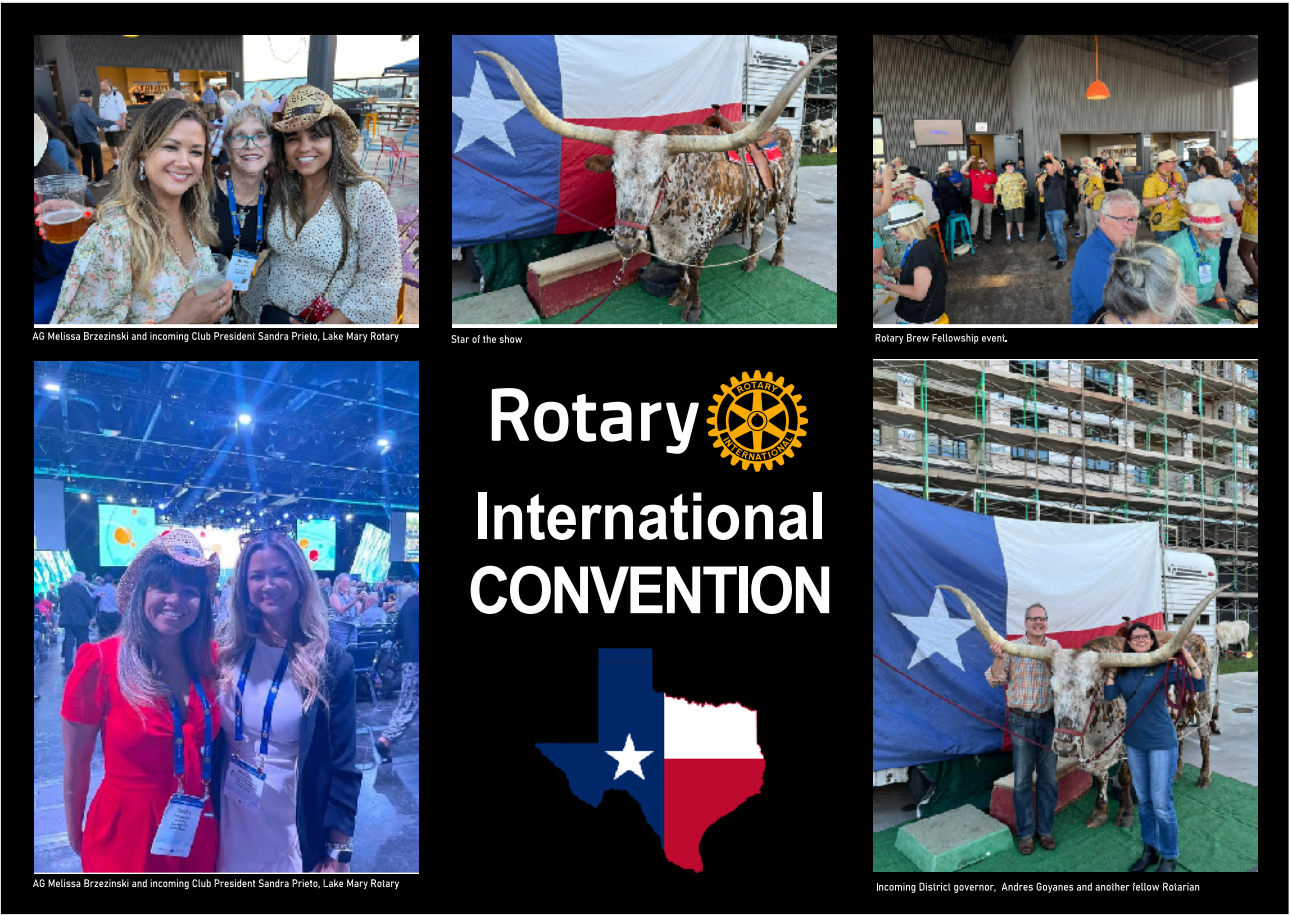
Dave's passionate commitment to New Hope for Kids has its roots in the grief he experienced following the death of his 16 year old son, John, in 1986. His work journey began in 1968 in the computer industry in Minnesota. Dave received a BS degree (65) in Business and Economics from St. Mary's University and an MBA from the University of Minnesota (68). Dave moved to Florida in 1978 as Human Resource Dir. At NCR Engineering & Manufacturing located in Lake Mary.

Dave formed TAI a software systems company in 1986 that focused on automating areas within the criminal justice system. Over a 14 year period Dave worked in the prison systems in a number of states and found an alarming number of inmates got on the "wrong path" after a parent's death that eventually took them to lockup.

During his years working at NCR, Dave served as United Way Campaign Chairman for Seminole County for 2 years and in 1980 he joined the Board of Directors of Hospice of Central Florida and served in a variety of volunteer roles for 15 years. He was a founding board member of New Hope for Kids in August 1996. In the summer of 2000 Dave sold his software systems business and in September took on the responsibilities of Executive Director at New Hope for Kids.

Dave served for 6-1/2 yrs. on the Board of Directors of the National Alliance for Grieving Children (NAGC). The NAGC is a nationwide network of children's bereavement support organizations, with professionals and volunteers who want to share ideas, information and resources to better support families they serve in their communities. Dave has also served as a Board member for the Leukemia Society, YMCA, Central Florida Employers Association and Board Chair of the Seminole County Private Industry Council.
