PP Lynn Gleiber was our speaker today, and she told us about her time as a flight attendant with Delta Air Lines. Lynn started in 1989 and worked for 14 years with Delta. Over the years, Delta merged with other airlines, including Chicago Southern, Northeast, Pan Am, Western, and Northwest. Delta was the first airline to buy fuel in advance to lock in low prices. Lynn showed us the history of the Delta logo and uniform and aircraft changes over the years. Lynn explained the training required, including for emergencies. The service provided by flight attendants has decreased a lot to cut costs, especially with food and drink. There used to be a strict appearance check where flight attendants had to be a certain weight. Lynn flew out of New Orleans for years, and then she transferred to New York City. Lynn flew to many European cities, Tel Aviv, Moscow, South American cities and West African cities. Lynn told us about the "Spirit of Delta" which was the first Boeing 767 aircraft, bought by Delta employees for Delta, as an appreciation for how Delta handled the tough economic times. Lynn had some celebrity visiting stories. Delta employees were one of the first groups to participate in the "October Pink Out" for cancer awareness.
