John Ingram introduced Steve Leichner, member of the Rotary Club of The Villages. Steve is the owner of PSL Travel but was here to talk about C.A.R.T. or Coins for Alzheimer's Research Trust. The goal of CART is to find ways to prevent Alzheimers and slowing down the progression of the disease by finding bio-markers for early detection. Knowing at the onset of the disease could be life changing as 1 in 6 people will develop Alzheimers. The Alzheimers Association is fundraising for caregivers of Alzheimers patients. They provide support groups and medical care for the caregivers. CART provides seed money for researchers then those scientists can give promising preliminary findings to the National Institute of Health for major funding. 3 of the previous years groups have been funded by NIH for millions of dollars. Taking donations for CART is easier with the blue buckets and cups to collect change.
