Assistant Governor Alex Sacharov introduced District Governor Cindi Cioci. Cindi opened with the new Rotary Vision Statement for 2019: "Together, we see a world where people unite and take action to create lasting change � across the globe, in our communities, and in ourselves.". Cindi is passionate about seeing Rotary grow and encouraged all of us to involve our families in what we do at our club. She wants to make a path to leadership viable, and promote diversity in those leadership positions. She encouraged all of us to remember how we got into Rotary and why we kept coming back. We could do the same and start a new member with someone else. Cindi guoted some stats about our club, chartered in 1968; total years of service: 1182; 72 active members (21 female); 4 members with over 40 years of service and Carla with 30 years. Cindi explained the Rotary Foundation Challenge: Asking members to make a promise to set aside \$1,000 in their Last Will & Testament. She also encouraged us to find and support a public image chair and a Foundation chair in each club. Also to send photos and information about our club to the district newsletter that comes out on the 1st of every month. Cindi spoke about a competition for service projects toward the end of the year at
