- Easter Seals has a 100-year history in partnership with Rotary to bring help too communities.
- Our support will go to the ♦ Daybreak at Miller Center ♦ ♦ provides daytime activities for elderly members of our community. One of their members is 100 years young!
 - The center also provides services for Diabetes and other ailments of the aging.
 - Veterans are also a large part of the program (VA is the only other source of funding besides public donations like ours for the local Easter Seals programs).
- Their programs are properly aligned with Social Distancing and other Determinants of current health guidelines.
- Some Financial Assistance can be provided by the program in emergency cases.
- Ten years ago, ES was named the leader in Arts and Wellness programs ♦ a position they have worked hard to maintain. Especially beneficial to the elderly.
- ES developed a strategy for dealing with COVID restrictions by providing ♦ drive by contact ♦ with elderly clients and now employ current social distancing and mask strategies to keep the program viable for the elderly in our community.
