Program:

Mark Mikhael (pharmacist by trade) gave us an overview of The Give Hope Foundation. The foundation is 19 years old, 100% volunteer, and serves pediatric cancer patients (mostly < 18 years old). Over \$2.5 million has been raised and donated since the foundation's inception. The foundation serves an average of 88 children per year with gifts of \$3-4 thousand dollars. Gifts are need based and used for expenses the families incur due to the child illness, not medical expenses. The foundation also has a scholarship fund. The main \$250K fundraiser is a gala held in October at the Rosin Shingle Creek Resort. The foundation has 9 board members and ~30 volunteers.
