Alejandro Morales of Winter Park Roadside was our speaker today. His company provides a 24/7 mobile locksmith service. He is the son of our own Vicky Morales. The seven-year old company has 2 employees and works in commercial, residential, automotive, safes and emergencies. Alejandro warned us about locksmith scams where, particularly, emergency calls turn into very expensive service jobs. Bait and switch tactics are used where low prices are quoted, but turn into high-cost jobs. Use caution when using Google searches to find locksmith companies. Make sure companies are local and have good reviews. Alejandro recommends key pad entry locks should also be able to be opened with a key. Keyless locks can be a problem when batteries go dead or power goes off. Alejandro also teaches game development and coding to young people.
