Speaker: Gunnar Skinderhaug, CFL and Deputy CEO of Atlantic Sapphire. Gunnar, moved to Homestead from Norway with his wife and 2 dogs to head up the largest land based salmon farm in the world! They enjoyed outdoor activities in Norway, such as skiing, hiking, etc.. Atlantic Sapphire is in Homestead and distributes domestically.

He says Norway's 2nd largest industry is salmon farming.

SPEAKER / TITLE OF PROGRAM

The USA is the largest consumer of salmon in the world yet has no domestic production. It is the largest market for salmon yet has no domestic salmon farms.

The farms drill 2000 feet for fresh salt water to fill their tanks, and pump the dirty water back down to 3000 feet. They keep the water cooled to 55 degrees all year round.

Atlantic Sapphire purchases fertilized eggs from Norway, Chile or Iceland. put them in fresh water, until they mature enough to move to salt water tanks. They mimic the life cycle of the fish from egg to mature fish by changing the light, the temperature and the type of water they are in.

Since the water is pumped from such a depth, it is very pure with no germs, parasites or viruses. The fish never get sick.

They are fed accordingly either a synthetic food that gives them a dark salmon colored meat or natural cray fish that gives them a natural color. The synthetic is most popular by the consumer because it is assumed to be fresher or healthier, in fact the duller color is a more natura. Buy Blue House Brand salmon from Publix


