# Today's Speaker/Program


President-elect Marcel Zangger gave a concluding talk about his pilgrimage to Santiago de Compostela in Spain.



He and a fellow pilgrim traveled 161 miles in ten days from Porto, Portugal to the Compostela cathedral in Spain. Lodging in pilgrim hostels (about \$16 a night) plus two nights in upscale hotels, he spent only \$300 for lodging the entire trip. Food, beers, and wines were wonderful and cheap, too. He described the hardships of hiking as something you learn to shrug off each day. Starting on "the coastal way (camino)", they crossed into Spain on the central way and arrived within their schedule to file a pilgrimage passport stamped with village visits to achieve their "Compostela" or certificate of achievement, at Santiago's cathedral. As Marcel said, he was "the youngest of the old" who hiked the route.
