Belkis Alvarez spoke about the newly-formed group, Miami-Dade Countryside Agri-Tourism Association. In addition, another group in the Redland opposes venue sites and routinely complains about noise and traffic despite the facts. The group is working with the police and county officials to improve business opportunities while promoting what the area has to offer.
