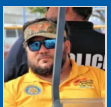

Today's Speaker/Program

Speaker

Quinton Glenn, Everglades Outpost, a non-profit animal sanctuary started by his father many years ago. Quinton has had a passion for wildlife ever since he was a little boy. He runs the outpost and is studying Biology at Miami Dade College. His main business is wildlife management, animal trapping and animal care. When animals become a nuisance, call Quinton to relocate them.

Many of the animals at Everglades Outpost are trapped and confiscated wild animals that cannot be returned to the wild nor kept anywhere else, including zoos. They have cougars, panthers, monkeys, a bear, a camel and many alligators and crocodiles.

An interesting fact, the difference between a gator and a crocodile is **not** "you'll see one later and one after a while"!! Their snouts are different. Gators are rounded with top teeth showing. Croc's snouts are narrow, almost pointed and their teeth mesh together.

There are only 2 types of alligators; American and Chinese.

There are over a dozen types of crocodiles, with the largest growing over 25 feet.

Good news! Neither likes the taste of humans, but rather they like to keep humans out of their territory.

So, if you get a chance, visit the outpost soon, not later or after a while!!
