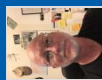

Mars Interact Polar Plunge

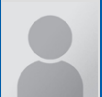

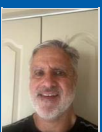

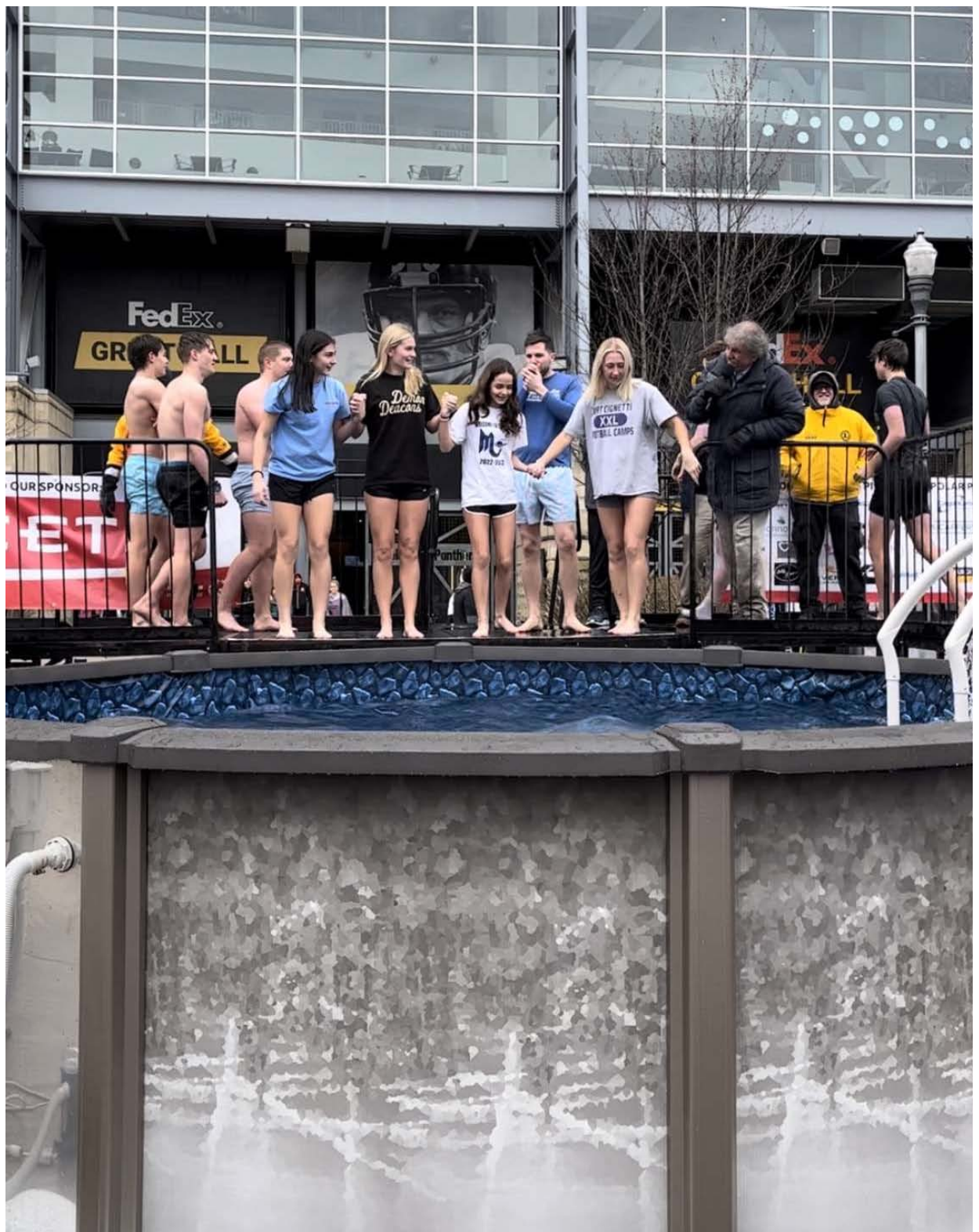
