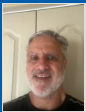

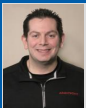

Pine-Richland Walk4Water Raises \$5000 for Well in Ghana

Dear World Changers!

The generosity surrounding the Pine-Richland High School Walk for Water event held on May 20, 2024 is amazing! Students of Pine-Richland, teachers and administrators at Pine-Richland, Rich-Mar Rotary Club, and Kiwanis Club came together and raised \$5,000! That generosity will make it possible for the village of Wugladza in Ghana to have clean water.

Today, over 400 people in Wugladza walk several miles each day to fetch water that no one with access to clean water would ever consider drinking. The watering hole where they get their water is muddy and is shared by local cattle and wildlife. Feces are visible around and in the water. Villagers suffer from skin diseases and diarrhea and many need to be hospitalized from waterborne diseases stemming from the dirty water.



But your generosity will soon change all of that! Work is underway to drill a borehole well and install a hand pump so that the people of Wugladza, Ghana will have access to clean water.
