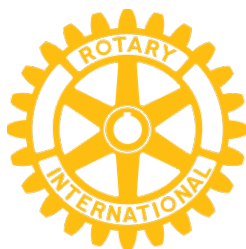

President's Message for July 14th

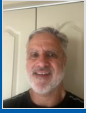

Next Week: I will talk about goals we set for the 24-25 Rotary Year.

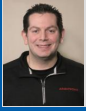

Event #2 - Inspired Hearts and Hands (IH2) 4th Annual Summerfest Friday, August 9, 2024

IH2™'s Empowered Scholar Program (ESP) focuses on providing children in poverty with nourishment, resources, and opportunities that promote rich, active learning and positive child development while setting a trajectory for continued growth and achievement. Each year, IH2 hosts both an in-person resource day as well as resource deliveries to school districts and subsidized communities throughout Butler, Beaver, Allegheny, and Armstrong Counties. The in-person event will take place at Broadstreet Elementary School on Friday, August 9 where more than 800 attendees are expected! SummerFest is an opportunity for students and their families to get excited about and prepared for the coming school year! They will have food, games, and activities, and a back-to-school shopping experience. Rich Mar Rotary is looking to join our satellite club in helping Inspired Hearts and Hands for the Summerfest.

In addition to volunteer needs at Summerfest on August 9th in Butler, additional volunteer help is needed at the Cranberry facility that Rich Mar visited last year to prep the clothing, backpacks and other materials, and load the trucks. **Opportunities to volunteer include loading the truck on August 5th and 6th at noon, a 6pm truck load on the 7th, 9am and 1130 AM truck loads on the 8th and perhaps a few more spots on the 9th.**
