Join your Rotarian friends before noon on July 24 at the Rich-Mar Rotary Pavilion in Adams Township Community Park. Our guest speakers will be Gary Peaco, Adams Township Manager, and Brian Perry, Parks and Recreation Director.

Adams Township once a stable, predominantly agricultural community, over the last couple of decades has been slowly transforming into more of a suburban bedroom community where the majority of residents commute to work outside of the Township (and the County). The influx of new residents into Adams shows that approximately 44% of the people who live in the Township have moved into their houses since 1980. As new residents move into the Township, Adams is becoming more diverse in terms of outlook, education, occupation and household size.

Adams Township Parks and Recreation aims to serve the greater township area in health, safety, and in preservation, first and foremost. The mission is to create recreational opportunities for growth and enhancement by developing diverse services and programs that promote citizen involvement and a strong sense of community while striving to increase social, cultural, and physical well-being of its residents and visitors.

We will discuss with Gary and Brian their plans and programs for the Township and Park and how our club can continue to support them. We may even get an update on the Rt. 228 project. Be sure to attend.
