August 21: Artificial Intelligence for Mental Health



We have all been hearing a lot about Artificial Intelligence (AI) lately - its positive promises and its negative possibilities. We'll join your Rotarian friends at noon on August 21 at Treedale to learn how AI is being used to help solve the drug addiction and mental health problems that Rotary has been addressing for the past year. Our speaker will be Ellie Gordon, founder and CEO of the Pittsburgh start-up company, **Behavior**. Feel free to invite a guest who may have an interest in this subject.

Behavior is on a mission to democratize addiction and mental health recovery using AI, behavioral health technology, and wearables for crisis aversion and mental health support. We help people stay on track with their recovery process by providing the right intervention at the right time, in real-time. We help care providers better serve their clients, and employers better serve their employees.

â€œRecoveryâ€ by **Behavior** is a portable toolbox that supports people in mental health and addiction recovery, their care providers, and their support network. It provides the right support at the right time, in real-time. â€œRecovery" includes connection to support networks and care providers for risk management, remote monitoring capability for care providers, a real-time alerting system for urgent assistance, and mental health and addiction self-management at home or on the go. A wearable recovery system that supports you, your client, or your loved one 24/7, in your day-to-day and in your time of need.



Ellie Gordon is the founder and CEO of Behavior, an award-winning health technology company. She is a behavioral technologist, designer, innovator, and entrepreneur. For over 17 years, her work has primarily focused on improving people's lives through technology. She has successfully created, organized, led, and managed teams for everything from hackathons and codefests to other science-based startups and initiatives to community development and research projects. She did a TEDx talk about her work with Behavior. She has led her team to win multiple awards, such as the Carnegie Science Award, two AI XPRIZE top 10 milestone awards for the global competition, NIH and NSF awards, a Tech Top 50 and CEO of the Year finalist, and was featured as a "New Generation Tech Entrepreneur" by the Pittsburgh Tech Council. Through her research, she has developed subject matter expertise on behavior and mental health, addiction, wearables, and using technology for sensing.

Rich-Mar Hosts a Picnic for the ARC of Butler Families

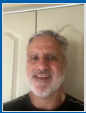

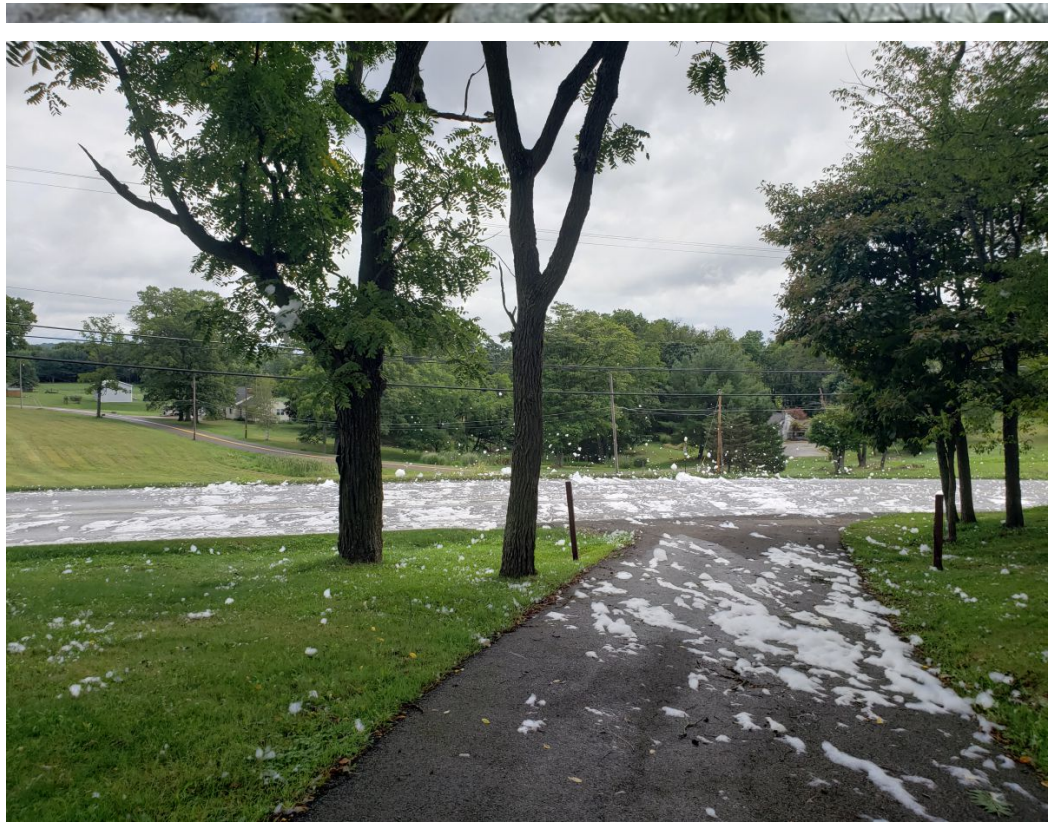
Rich-Mar Hosts a Foam Party for the Mars Area Library
