### Jim Roddey to speak on September 14th.



On Wednesday, September 14 our speaker will be Rich-Mar Rotary member Jim Roddey. Jim is originally from Asheville, NC, graduated from TCU, and served as a marine. In 1979 he moved to Pittsburgh from Atlanta where he was President of Turner Communications Corp.. He was the first Chief Executive of Allegheny County, from 2000 to 2004, and was chair of the Allegheny County Republican Committee from 2005 unit 2016. He is a businessman who has served on a number of corporate and public boards, including the University of Pittsburgh where he is an Emeritus Trustee. Jim has four Paul Harris Awards including one from Rich-Mar Rotary and has spoken to more than 30 Rotary Clubs and functions in six states and three countries. Jim will discuss with us the question of whether the Pennsylvania primary elections should be opened to voters who are not registered to a political party. Two bills on this matter are now being considered in the General Assembly. Join us to take part in the discussion of this important current issue.
