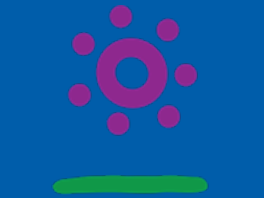
No Meeting on September 28th

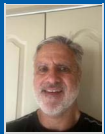
