District Grants with Ron Gigler

Ron mentioned emails sent out this week. The district has \$1,500 to divide up any way you want as a club, right now we have multiple projects outstanding. Ron went over the dictionary program, as well as Operation Warm to get additional information from Maizee - George Evans did Operation Warm in Bedford - where the company takes recycled bottles and they turn into coats. We ask local organizations what their need is buy them coats. Ron mentioned during COVID there were limited supply. Ron mentioned doing a project for Living in Liberty for hygiene packets and cooking a dinner for 35. Ron mentioned supporting Parents in TOTO in December and discussed maybe supporting a project there.

Membership with Elayne Wilhelm

Elayne mentioned a membership summit on Sept 17th in Franklin, PA that is a membership summit its an all day meeting. Mike mentioned doing a happy hour for social membership.

Foundation with Kim Reuss

We do have a new Paul Harris, but to be announced. Kim mentioned we had 14-15 Paul Harris fellows - that is \$1,000 donation - this helps with grant funding, but also clean water, nutrition, health, etc. and great opportunity to give back to others in different countries. The Cranberry Noon club is kicking our butt at \$500 per member - Rotary requires \$100 per person per year. We are less than 50% of the noon club and Kim would like to see us step it up.
