Raised billions of dollars to end Polio – 3 billion children have received the polio vaccine. 19 million people are walking who would otherwise have been paralyzed. PolioPlus has helped with other vaccine-preventable diseases. Majority of money raised goes to operational support. Wild polio in Afghanistan and Pakistan have come up as well as Malawi. In 2020 Africa was polio free. We could make history to eradicate polio from the country. PolioPlus society is \$100 a year and ask for commitment for 3 years. Hoping that gets our district more regenerated. If you go into MyRotary – you can login – Aaron Sines helped a ton – after the fall workshop we will have an awareness happy hour to help raise awareness. 40 pages just on Polio.
