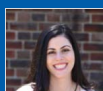

Tom has been in the area for 24 years. His team will be featured with Marty Griffith on the radio. They will finish up with a large fundraising picnic in Monroeville on May 20. They are looking for donations for their silent auction.

Man of the Year (there is also a Woman of the Year) is a competition to raise the most money for LLS. Candidates know how much they raise but not what other candidates have raised to date. Typically, LLS has a large party at the end of the 10-week campaign and reveal the Man and Woman of the Year plus the total amount that the candidates have raised.
