



Well that's history! At the Council on Legislation, COL, this past April, the representatives voted to give you the entire Rotary year. (Article 10 of the revised Standard Rotary Club Constitution)

Why? Because a lot of clubs have many events in a very short period of time and members work those but can't use the credit to offset absences. For example, in one month you have a park cleanup and a fundraiser and committee meetings. You have 3 potential make-ups, but you only miss 1 club meeting and, therefore, 2 make-ups don't count. Now you can "bank" those make-ups and they can be used at any time during the Rotary Year (July 1-June 30).

Again, these make-ups can be used anytime during the year, so absences in July or August of 2019 can be offset by make-ups that happen before June 30, 2020.
