"Closer to Canada Than Memphis: The Campaign for a Medical School at ETSU"



Fred Sauceman has witnessed the growth of the Quillen College of Medicine at East Tennessee State University from various perspectives. As both a radio and television news reporter through the 1970s, Fred covered the complicated politics that led to the college's creation and the early days of uncertainty as the college was pursuing accreditation. When he was hired to head up the University Relations division at ETSU in 1985, he began working almost daily with College of Medicine faculty, staff, and students to share their stories. In the early 2000s, he began piecing together notes left by ETSU President Emeritus Dr. D.P. Culp, who had intended to write the firsthand history of the college. Fred has built upon Dr. Culp's beginning to create a 40,000+-word history of that political battle, and

today he will share some highlights of that history.

Fred is himself a graduate of ETSU, receiving a Bachelor of Arts degree in English and History in 1978 and a Master of Arts degree in English in 1980. He was present, in May of 1982, to see the first class of graduates earn their M.D.s from the ETSU College of Medicine.
