Grades PreK - 4 - Karen Anderson (Lake Ridge Elementary)

Karen Anderson currently teaches 4th grade Science and Social Studies at Lake Ridge Elementary, where she has been for the past three years. In all, Karen has 33 years of teaching experience and has spent the last 23 years in K-12 education. An ETSU graduate for both her undergraduate and Master's Degree in Early Childhood Education, Karen has served on numerous leadership committees.
