George Quarles-Head Football Coach ETSU

On Thursday, Dec. 23, 2021, George Quarles was introduced as the 19th Head Coach in Buccaneer Football history. A native of Jefferson County, Tennessee, Quarles arrived in Johnson City after five years as Associate Head Coach at Furman University (he also served as Offensive Coordinator and Quarterbacks coach the past four seasons). During that time, Furman made FCS Playoff appearances in 2017 and 2019, and earned a share of the regular-season SoCon Championship in 2018.

Quarles has strong ties to the state of Tennessee, having been inducted into both the Tennessee Football Coaches and Tennessee Secondary School Athletics Association Halls of Fame in 2018. He is also a member of the Tennessee Sports Hall of Fame and Greater Knoxville Sports Hall of Fame. He was the head coach at Maryville High School for 18 seasons, during which his teams went 250-16 (.939), making him one of the most successful prep coaches in the United States. The fastest coach in U.S. high school football history to register 200 wins, he guided Maryville to 11 state championships and, during one stretch, a nation's-best 74 consecutive victories. A seven-time state coach of the year selection, he was named Tennessee Titans Coach of the Year in 2005 and PrepXtra Coach of the Year in 2005 and 2013.

Quarles earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in political science from Furman in 1989 and later secured a Master's of Education degree in administration and supervision from Lincoln Memorial University. As a collegiate player, he led Furman with 18 receptions for 295 yards during his senior year, helping the Paladins finish 13-2, win the SoCon championship, and claim the NCAA FCS (I-AA) national title.

He and his wife, Leslie, have two sons: Jack and Beau.
