Bill Greer-Milligan University President

Dr. Bill Greer has served as President of Milligan University since 2011. Joining the college in 1994 as Professor of Economics and Business Administration, he also served as the college's Vice President for Institutional Advancement from 2006 until 2011. He graduated from Milligan in 1985 and holds an MBA from East Tennessee State University and a PhD in Economics from the University of Tennessee – Knoxville. Under Greer's leadership, Milligan has set new enrollment and fundraising records and the endowment has seen significant growth. Emmanuel Christian Seminary became part of Milligan in 2015 and a number of new programs, including engineering and physician assistant studies, have been added. As a result, Milligan College became Milligan University in June of 2020.

Greer is past Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Tennessee Independent Colleges and Universities Association and also past President of the Tennessee College Association. Greer is a member of the Board of Directors of the Bank of Tennessee and the Johnson City-Jonesborough-Washington County Chamber of Commerce. He sits on the Council of Presidents for the Appalachian Athletic

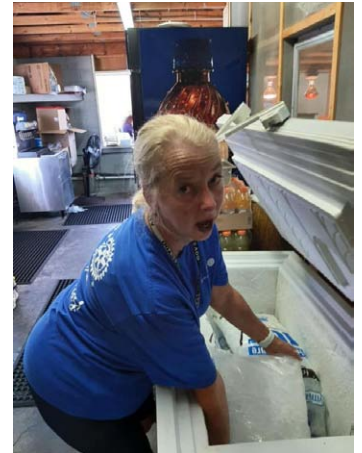
Association and is a past member of the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics Council of Presidents.

Bicycle Playground Park Project-Rotary

The board has approved fundraising for a new bicycle playground for Johnson City, Tn. What is a bicycle playground?

Many people live in neighborhoods where kids don't have a safe place to learn to ride, so they end up trying to learn on the sidewalk or in the street. In a neighborhood with a bicycle playground, parents can teach kids to ride in an area created just for that. Open spaces allow for better sightlines for parents to watch their kids without getting in the way of their fun.

There's added motivation for kids to learn to ride, since they're witnessing other kids riding and having fun. Your kids may improve their social skills while building confidence in their own abilities.

Bicycle playgrounds have benefits that kids never think about yet sit at the top of the list for recreation professionals, such as getting kids outside, learning balance, gaining strength, focusing on and completing tasks, and interacting with other kids. Bicycle playgrounds also teach kids to practice taking turns as they complete laps around the track. Children who are physically active at a young age are more likely to maintain their physical fitness through adulthood, which reduces age-related maladies and diseases.
