Synethia White is the Community Violence Prevention Manager for the City of Newport News. She has over 15 years of experience in public service at the local and state level. She has established citizen-led community-based initiatives, organized regional violence prevention efforts in Hampton Roads, facilitated process improvement efforts, extensive

proposal development, and experience managing grants valued at over \$1,000,000. Previously working in local government (Hampton and Newport News, Virginia) and the State of Virginia at Virginia Commonwealth University. Before joining the City of Newport News, she served as the Director of Strategic Initiatives with Cities United. In that role, she was responsible for designing, strengthening, and implementing Cities United's strategic vision related to national programming and partner city engagement. She led the team responsible providing coaching to Mayors and Offices of Violence Prevention across the country as they developed comprehensive public safety plans. Synethia earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from Old Dominion University and a Certificate in Non-Profit Management from Tidewater Community College.

Synethia is a supporter of the Nutrition Education Advisory Board at the Food Bank of the Virginia

Peninsula, a member of the Hampton Roads Affiliate of National Black Child Development Institute, the Bethea Family Foundation, a founding board member of the Hampton Roads Police Athletic League and was appointed to the Virginia Department of Juvenile Justice Board by Governor Northam in 202. She is a member of the Hampton Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.
