Appointed Executive Director in December 2016, Kleinhample established a vision to reenergize natural science education through exemplary guest experience and the highest standards of animal welfare at the Virginia Living Museum, taking the Museum from where we've always been to where we need to be. Under Kleinhample's leadership, the Museum is completing an aggressive strategic plan that increases program services and delights over 290,000 guests a year. She continues to drive financial sustainability through earned and contributed income, improved efficiencies with tight budgeting and data based decisions. At the heart of this community built, beloved, and sustained organization is a mission to connect people to nature through educational experiences that promote conservation. Kleinhample works to ensure the same for generations to come. The Museum serves as a community anchor, a priceless economic driver and resource to area residents and visiting tourists. By delivering Natural Science and Environmental Education through popular and fun hands-on live demonstrations, exhibits and programs for all ages, the museum mission is even more relevant now as it was at the

founding in 1966. Kleinhample's next objective is to engage all stakeholders in a new Strategic Plan; a plan with a focused vision to share natural science education to captivate learners of all ages through the health and wellbeing of their local environment. She believes both career pipelines for students are built through inspiration and that continuing education informs and builds global citizens for the planet. Kleinhample's experience spans the nation with career highlights in marketing and hotel/tourism management with The Lodge at Pebble Beach, CA, the US Army Club System in Europe and a chain of 17 convenience stores based in Lawton, OK. Rebecca joined the VLM Development team in 2004 and supported the Museum's growth through membership and contributions. Rebecca increased annual operating support threefold through charitable donations, special events, and grants in addition to a successful 50th Anniversary Future Ready \$5M Campaign. Rebecca has decades of volunteer community leadership experience. She currently serves our community as the Grants Chair for the Warwick at City Center Rotary Club. Kleinhample holds a B.S. in Science and a minor in Business from the Pennsylvania State University. She is a graduate of Northwestern University Kellogg School of Management with a certificate in Nonprofit Management. She grew up outside gardening with her father, fishing, skating on frozen lakes and exploring the creeks and woods of Pennsylvania. She and her husband, Robert, raised their two children in Hampton and currently reside in Williamsburg, VA.

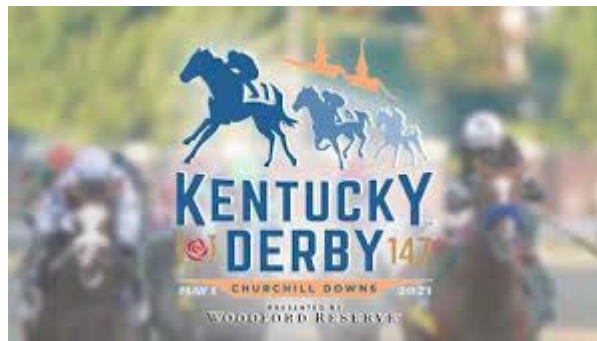
