Public Health Researcher & PhD Student

Michelle is pursuing a unique PhD focusing on Healthcare System Vulnerability -- the study of how resilient our healthcare system is in the face of potential hazards (including pandemic).

Her proposal for this program emphasizes the possibility of disastrous outcomes occurring when a weakened healthcare system is coupled with a seemingly ever-increasing number of societal disasters. She argues that greater study of this frontline infrastructure is desperately needed. Her presentation will cover some general concepts of disaster, as well as introduce healthcare system vulnerability. Parallels to the current pandemic situation should be evident.

While not pursuing her doctorate, Michelle is also occasionally contracted as a public health researcher. She has worked with the U.S. military and major research institutions. Virginia Tech remains a favorite partner in both education and employment, having worked on many research and policy writing projects. Her favorite project so far has been the development of Virginia Tech's Infectious Disease Outbreak Control Plan.
