Speaker: John Paul Harper - April

Born Andrews, SC on Jan. 3, 1924. Attended Presbyterian College until drafted in 1942. Served in the 8th Air Force, 2nd Air Division, 492nd Bomb Group as a nose gunner on a B-24. Deployment from 6/7/1944 through 6/18/1945, which included the air offensive in Europe, Normandy, and Northern France. Stationed at the air base in North Pickenham, England. On August 4, 1944, plane was shot down during a mission over Kiel, Germany. Captured, interrogated, and sent to Stalag Luft IV. In February 1945, was among the prisoners who were forced to march over 500 miles until they were liberated at Bitterfeld, Germany in April 1945.

After being discharged from service in 1945, returned to college on the GI bill, and graduated from North Carolina State University with a degree in Forestry. Started working for International Paper Company and retired from Chesapeake Corporation as Vice President. Married for 67 years, widowed for 10, and has four children, five grandchildren, and three great grandsons. Hobbies included hunting, fishing, golf and travel. Currently lives in West Point, Virginia.
