Speaker: Jill Schuler - June 14 2024

Jill Schuler became Assistant State Underwater Archaeologist for the Virginia Department of Historic Resources in 2022. In 2023 she defended her thesis, "Guns and Ships and so the Balance Shifts: Using Artifact Patterning to Contextualize a Salvaged Assemblage Dated to the Battle of Yorktown, 1781." She graduated with her MA from the Maritime Studies program at East Carolina University. In addition to her work in Virginia, Jill also works for the North Carolina African American Heritage Commission as the research historian for the Tale of Two Ships project, researching and publicizing the famed pirate ship Queen Anne's Revenge's previous life as the French slave ship La Concorde. She is also a board member of the North Carolina Maritime History Council and associate editor of their peer-reviewed journal, Tributaries
