Speaker: Philip Page - June 28 2024



Governor John Page, born at Rosewell in 1743, was a politician in Colonial Virginia, arguably the most influential leader in Gloucester history. He served in Virginia's House of Burgesses, William & Mary's Board of Visitors, Virginia's House of Delegates, the US Congress, and as 13th Governor of Virginia. We will review the Page history of Colonial Williamsburg, Page's upbringing, his view on religion and politics, his accomplishments, and his relationships with other notable leaders in Colonial Williamsburg, with the goal of understanding the evolution of thought in the founding of our country.

Bio of Philip Page

Philip Page, a Gloucester County resident, is a descendant of Gov Page's uncle, John Page of North End. A former VP of the Rosewell Foundation, he is married to Anne Page, a fourth-great grandchild of Gov. John Page. Since moving back to Gloucester, he has studied Page family history to share with his children and grandchildren. When not reading local history or tending to the Page family farm, he sells engineering software to the automotive industry. Philip has a B.Eng and M.Eng in mechanical engineering from Vanderbilt University. He also holds a CFA charter.
