## Speaker: Holly Koons - June 7 2024

**Bio:** Holly Koons is the executive director of the new Mary M. Torggler Fine Arts Center at Christopher Newport University. She brings her vision for the Center as it supports the core mission of the University and engages the public through excellence in its exhibitions and educational programming.

Koons is the former executive director of the Arlington (Va.) Arts Center where, over a four-year span, she directed the organization's administration, development, and creative strategy. Previously, she amassed twenty years of experience in non-profit visual arts curation and management including serving as executive director of the Greater Reston (Va.) Arts Center (now the Tephra Institute of Contemporary Art) and director of collections and exhibitions at the Telfair Museums in Savannah, Georgia. There, she was responsible for the care, display, and interpretation of the Telfair's collection of nearly 5,000 works of art, as well as an ambitious schedule of twelve to sixteen changing exhibitions annually. Koons participated in planning the Telfair's new contemporary building, and developed and presented dozens of exhibitions there. She holds a BA from the University of Georgia in English and Art History, and a MA in Art History from the University of Notre Dame.
