Guiding Eyes for the Blind

After many years of medical practice management and consulting, Eve left the corporate world behind to pursue her passion " helping dog owners improve their relationship with their canine companions, which is the foundation for successful training. Her approach addresses improvement of common behavior issues such as jumping, leash pulling and reactivity, as well as poor recall among many others.

Eva began raising pups for Guiding Eyes for the Blind 10 years ago while still working in medical practice management. The dogs she raised did come to work with her. They learned how to be comfortable and feel safe in an office environment, and how to appropriately interact with staff and patients.

Guiding Eyes for the Blind provides extensive training for their puppy raisers, but over the years, Eva became more and more interested in how dogs learn, what support they need to become happy, well-adjusted companions. She obtained certification through CATCH Academy and formed Simply Human Dog Training LLC. She hopes that through her work, she will help spread the word that compassion and play are more effective tools in training dogs, than pain and punishment.
