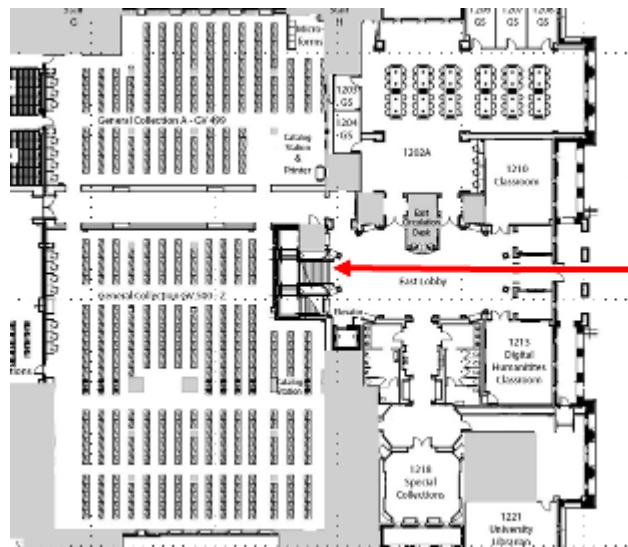

Founded by members of *Suffolk Presbyterian Church* in Suffolk, Virginia, *Edmarc* was named for Edward, their minister who died of cancer, and a young couple's son, Marcus, who needed hospice care because he had a progressive neuromuscular disease.
