PG Rotarians & Blood Donations

The need for blood is constant. Every day, Rotarians donate blood to help patients of all ages: accident and burn victims, heart surgery, organ transplant patients and those battling cancers. Every two seconds, someone in the US needs blood.

There are no age limitations on those donating blood. You can give blood as long as you are healthy and there are no restrictions or limitations on your activities. Whole blood can be donated, at least, 6 times a year or every 56 days. Blood is donated in units (pints); each unit

saves about 3 lives.

Member, Lillian Boyd, considers herself a more recent donor in that she only began donating since retiring and learning of the urgent need for her blood type. Having only recently received her two gallon (16 unit) donor pin, she continued her donation this week at the Hopewell Library where she received a special Shark Week Donor T-Shirt. The shirt is available to donors through July 31. Check your local donor sites for more information.
